

**NOTICE TO PASSENGERS REGARDING RIDE-SHARING  
TRANSPORTATION COMPANIES INCLUDING  
UBER, SIDECAR AND LYFT**

All commercial companies providing ground transportation at the Airport (e.g. taxis, limousines and buses) must be permitted. Permitted companies are obligated to meet certain requirements established by the Airport in regard to the company and drivers. As an example, each permitted company must show evidence of \$500,000 of auto liability insurance. Currently, no ride-share operations have requested or obtained the requisite permit to pick up passengers from Manchester-Boston Regional Airport.

Passengers who elect to arrange for a non-permitted ride-share operator to pick them up at the Airport should be aware of the following:

- The Airport does not “know” the company or driver. The Airport assumes no responsibility in respect to your ride-share transportation.
- Any non-permitted company or driver picking up passengers on Airport premises is in violation of the Airport’s Rules and Regulations for Ground Transportation.
